As you may know elections for Cornwall Council and St Austell Town Council are due to take place on 6th May 2021. The number of Cornwall Council members is being reduced from 123 to 87, hence the wards have been re-drawn and increased in size. Parts of Mount Charles will now be joining Poltair.

Students in St Austell now have to travel to Truro or Bodmin if they wish to study at A Level, because Cornwall College can no longer offer courses here.

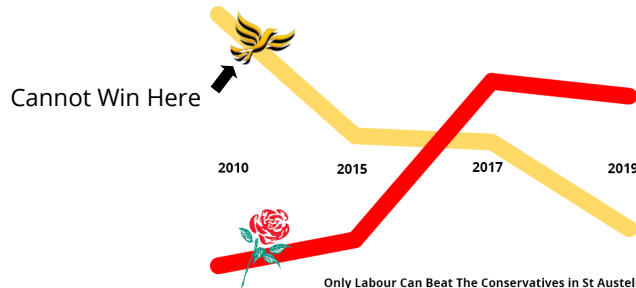
